Experience Global Virtual Teams



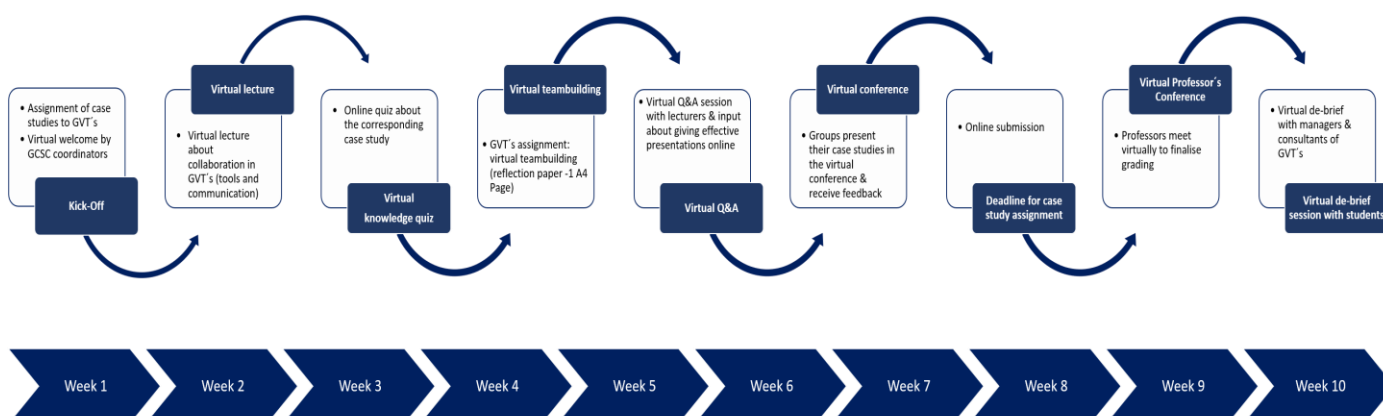
- **Knowledge transfer** strategies in global virtual teams

- Becoming familiar with and using various **digital tools for communication and collaboration**

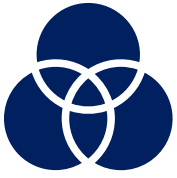
Spark Curiosity
